Student Code of Conduct

Students are viewed as “ambassadors” of our Barbershop Harmony Society “Youth in Harmony” programs at all times. The way you behave during the entire camp matters. Best behavior is expected. If you have a problem during the camp, please let one of the staff members know about it. He or she will do their best to help you.

1. Housing and roommate assignments are made based on certain criteria. Do not change rooms without the knowledge and approval of the camp administrator and your chaperone.
2. Do not abuse school property. The cost of repair of any abuse or destruction of school property will be charges directly to the person held responsible.
3. Faculty and chaperones are volunteers who are here to help give you the opportunity to have a positive musical experience. Please respect them and follow their instructions. Report to your chaperone at the appointed times.
4. When you are on the risers in rehearsal, please keep all distraction to a minimum. Direct all questions to the director or staff member in charge. Leave the risers only at scheduled break times or when absolutely necessary. Limit talking.
5. Students must stay on the campus at all times, unless accompanied by an adult teacher or staff member. Chaperones must be made aware of each camper’s whereabouts at all times.
6. Avoid singing in areas where our sound might not be appreciated, such as outside late at night. Avoid providing an opportunity for unappreciative listeners to criticize.
7. Be on time for all scheduled events. Schedules will be posted in several places, and times will be announced. Honor the curfews that are set. Be in your room and do not leave your room after “lights out”.
8. Lock your room when leaving it. There are other groups who will have access to the building. Report any suspicious activity to your chaperone.
9. Wear clothes that do not have slogans of questionable taste or that reference the use of alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
10. Cell phones must not be used during practice sessions. This includes text messaging.
11. The following actions may warrant an immediate call to parents, and dismissal from the camp:
Alcohol / Drug / Tobacco Use
Fighting
Possession of weapons, fireworks, drugs or tobacco
Any action that the chaperones/staff view as overly inappropriate
12. Turn in your room key before leaving the camp. A \$15 fee will be charged to the camper that does not turn in his room key upon check-out. A fee may also be charged to the camper that does not return his meal card.
