

DIXIE SENIOR & JUNIOR CHORUSES & QUARTETS REPRESENT AT BHS MIDWINTER

SILVER RING

The Dixie District representatives to the Barbershop Harmony Society's 2019 Midwinter Convention all gave spectacular performances, challenging for top honors in all categories.

Dixie District Senior Chorus competed with 50 members under the direction of Jimmy They sang, "You Tell Me Your Tompkins.

Dream" and "How's Every Little Thing In Dixie" and received a "superior" rating from the judges. They were one of four (out of eight) choruses receiving "superior" with the men from Ozark Overtones winning the championship.

In the senior quartet contest, our Dixie Senior Quartet Champs, Silver Ring (Bob Davenport, Jimmy Tompkins, Nick Daley, Paul Wietlisbach), placed seventh with a 74.1. Their setlist included "Always" and "The Gang That Sang Heart of My Heart." Also representing Dixie in a more northern route, the Cardinal Senior Quartet Champs, cityScape (Allen Reynolds, Howard McAdory, Antony Clifton, and Jay Hawkins) medaled with a 5th place finish and a score of 75.5. performed, "I'm Sorry I Made You Cry" and "So Long, Dearie."

In the Next Generation Junior Quartet contest, 3:1, from the Martin Luther King, Jr. Magnet School in Nashville, TN, received a rating of "outstanding" and a score of 19.2 earning a 4th place finish. 3:1 performed "Love Me And The World Is Mine." Sonic Sound Quartet, from Marietta High School in Marietta, GA, finished with an "excellent" rating in 13th

place with a score of 13.8, singing "No No Norman."

Dixie had three choruses representing in the Next Generation Junior Chorus contest. In the Plateau AA competition there were two choruses. Bro Re Mi from Martin Luther King, Jr. Magnet School in Nashville, TN sang "Angels

We Have Heard On High," "The Open Road," and "You're Welcome." They received a rating of "good" with 38 young men on the stage, directed by Cody Duff. Georgia Spirit, representing Atlanta Metro, from Atlanta, GA, performed "Ob La Di, Ob La Da," "I Will," and "HELP! Medley." They are under the direction of Becki Hine, and Lars

Grevstad and received a rating of "outstanding" with 40 young men and women on stage. From Plateau AAA, **Bella Voca**, from the Martin Luther King, Jr. Magnet School in Nashville, TN and under the direction of Cody Duff, sang "Beauty and the Beast," "La Violette," and "The Lion Sleeps Tonight." They competed with 68 young women and received a rating of "good."

Congratulations to all of our Dixie choruses and quartets, and NextGen Champs. Wildfire, and thank you for making us proud.

Registration on site will be open: 12:00 Noon -1 hour after quartet contest starts Friday March 20.8:00 AM - 1 Hour after chorus contest starts Saturday March 21. Early-bird registration for contestants is \$50 plus Eventbrite's handling fee, full registration after that will be \$10 more. Friday and Saturday tickets are available to attend in the audience for family, friends, and those not competing. Registration FAQ

Q: Do I have to bring my printed ticket to the event? **A:** Yes. It will be exchanged at either the contest site or registration for an event ticket.

Q: Is my registration fee or ticket transferrable? **A:** Yes. You can transfer your registration to someone else.

Q: If it is just my wife and me do we get a family registration? **A:** No. The family registration is designed to help out families with children come to the contest. If you are registering less than 3 people individual registrations will be less expensive.

Q: Will name badges be printed? **A:** No. To keep costs low we stopped printing name badges years ago. Most all chapter members have a name badge so please wear your name badge to the contests.




