Lake Lanier GA Sends 4 Kids To Dixie Harmony Explosion Camp

Recently the Lake Lanier, Ga. chapter membership was presented a proposal to send a high school student who was interested in singing barbershop harmony to the Dixie District Harmony Explosion Camp in Chattanooga from July 10 to July 13 at a cost of \$175 per camper.

David Haas, treasurer, was pleased to tell the group that they had a benefactor who had pledged to match members' contributions up to \$175 to sweeten the pot a bit. That first night the chapter collected \$92 for the fund and was off to a great start. On the following Tuesday they collected an additional \$90 from the membership, plus \$175 from one member, who wanted to sponsor a camper! One week later they collected another \$62, and our total collected stood at \$594! We were suddenly close to sending an entire quartet to camp! Our final push came on May 7 with a goal to collect \$56 to have enough to send four campers. The chapter reached deep into their pockets, and our take for the night came to \$57. We now have enough to send four campers this year with \$1 in seed money for next year.

We're working with the Alpha Male VLQ at Alpharetta (Ga.) High School to see if there are four of their members that would be interested in attending the camp. We're also are encouraging their music teacher to attend the camp as a guest of the district. If we don't have four students from Alpharetta High School that are able to attend, we'll reach out to other high schools in the area to find participants. Thanks again to the chapter membership for pulling this off. Your generosity will help to give a big boost in expanding barbershop harmony in the local high schools, which is so important to the continuation of our music style. s a result of Andy Doetsch's efforts, (a North Georgia Barbershop Singer) five high school-age boys make their Barbershop debut in an Alpharetta High School concert.

Several weeks ago, Andy Doetsch, a teacher at the Alpharetta High

School introduced barbershop to the men's chorus. Five of the boys showed interest and stepped up to

the challenge. After a few rehearsals, the boys had mastered the art of barbershop singing.

Were they champions? Yes, in the eyes of their peers, they were indeed champions! They exhibited courage and harmonized as any barbershop quartet is trained to do. They sang a very challenging arrangement of, "Wait Till the Sun Shines, Nellie", which brought much applause from their peers in the audience. The sky is the limit for these young men.



Andy had the boys quartet and Pickup Stix sing together as a VLQ (Very Large Quartet) later in the "Honey/Little program, singing. Lize", an old standard within the BHS, (Barbershop Harmony Society). It was a win-win experience for both the young men and barbershop in general, as well as the 600 people in the audience.



The "Pickup Stix," a well-seasoned quartet from the North Georgia barbershop singers, from Cumming, Ga., also sponsored the Alpharetta boys quartet and sang in support of the them. They sang a new show tune called, "You've Got a Friend In Me", which contains the hallmarks of the barbershop style, syncopated rhythm and a jazz with a flavor that is popular among the younger set.
