2017 Real Men Sing Performance

The Big Chicken Chorus will be presenting its annual "Real Men Sing Performance" at the Marietta Performing Arts Center, 1171 Whitlock Avenue in Marietta on the campus of Marietta High School on Saturday, September 9th at 7 PM. This performance is open to all and admission is FREE.

This performance immediately follows a choral clinic for young men in area middle schools and high schools. In addition to the **Big Chicken Chorus** the performance will include performances by the Middle School clinic participants, the High School clinic participants, and the clinic teaching quartets – **The Simple Life** and **Pratt Street Power.**

The Simple Life includes the Clinicians of choral clinic, Michael O'Neill and Kevin Mendez. The quartet boasts a wealth of medals earned in International Competitions, as well as degrees and advanced study in Music Education, Performance, and Choral Conducting.

Pratt Street Power is based in Baltimore, MD and is the 2016 International Youth Barbershop Quartet Champions.
